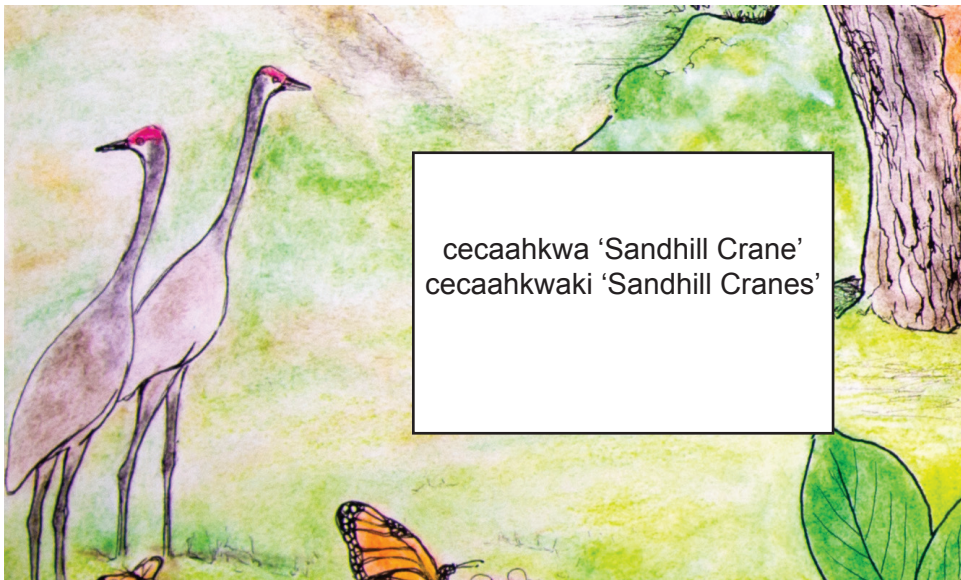

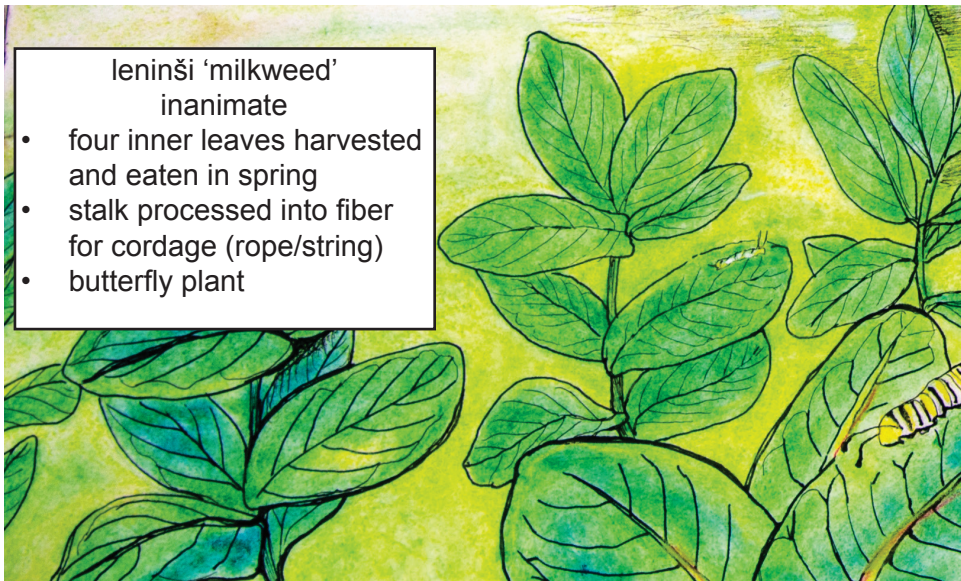


moohswa 'White-tail Deer'

- butterfly plant

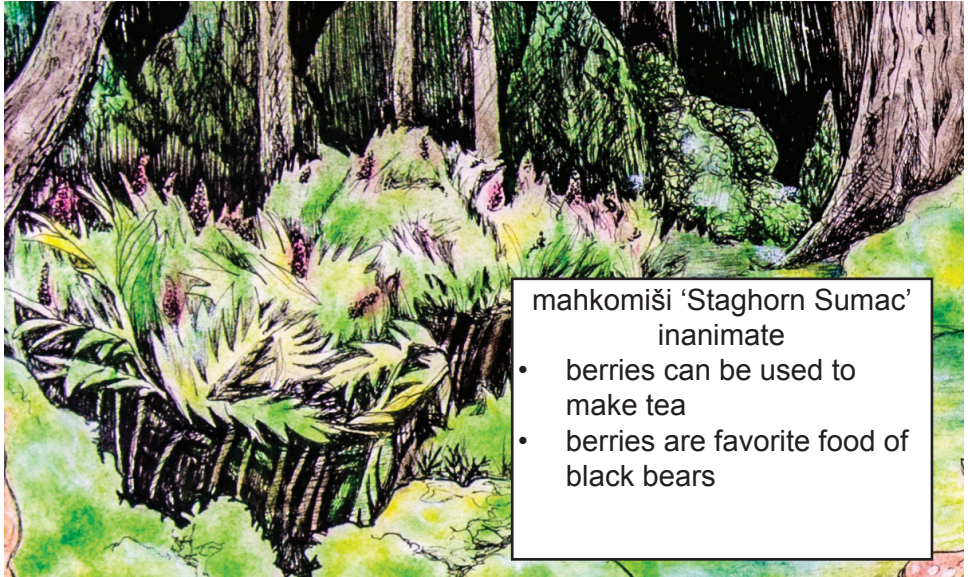






apahkwaya 'cattail'
